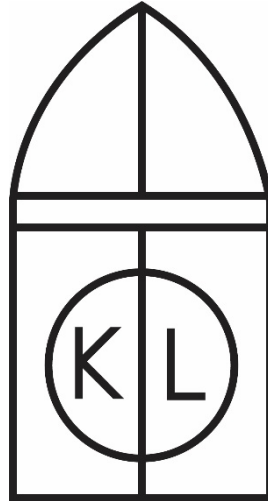

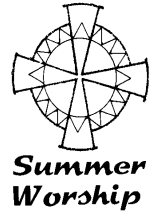

## Update on our Financial Results to the end of May, 2019

We are almost halfway through the year, and I wanted to bring everyone up to date on our operating results to the end of May. The results are a bit mixed. The following are the totals of our revenues and expenses, and the resulting surplus (or deficit) that comes from subtracting expenses from revenues. All numbers are in \$1,000.

Expenses	\$328	\$352	\$278
Surplus (Deficit)	(\$26)	(\$43)	\$9

We are doing better than the budget that we set for ourselves, although not nearly as well as we were doing at this point in time last year.
