Invitation to Communion:

All: O God, we confess that we have fallen short in what we have said and done, and in what we have failed to say and do.

We confess this to you and before one another. We ask your forgiveness and the power to be new people. Amen.

One: Jesus said often, "Your sins are forgiven; your faith has made you whole." Through His life, death and resurrection we are assured that God loves us, understands our weaknesses, forgives and strengthens us.

Sharing the Peace of Jesus Christ

All: It is good to do so.

One: We thank you, God, that you created all things; this earth and the universe of which it is a part, that you have made us like yourself and for yourself; and that you care for all you have made.

One: O God, we thank you that our Lord lived and died. We thank you and we praise you because Jesus overcame death and rose again. Before you, O God, by what we do here, we celebrate the life and presence of Jesus Christ.
